

**Memorial Hermann *Advantage* (HMO)/
Memorial Hermann Dual *Advantage* (HMO D-SNP)
Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare
to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs**

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare.

If you get extra help, your monthly plan premium will be \$0 for any of the plan(s) below. (This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.)

- Memorial Hermann Advantage (HMO)

Memorial Hermann Dual *Advantage* (HMO D-SNP)'s premium includes coverage for both medical services and prescription drug coverage.

If you are receiving Extra Help (known as a Low-Income Subsidy), then **Memorial Hermann Dual *Advantage* HMO D-SNP** might be a better option to you. If you have more questions, please call the Customer Service number listed at the end of the letter or on the back of your ID card.
